



Download the firmware and save it to a location of your choice.


Launch the firmware program and select **Run**. Click **Yes** at the security screen pop-up and click **Next** on the Welcome screen.



Insert a USB memory device into your PC, select **Create an .img file for upgrade via USB device** and click **Next**. Select **Browse**, select your USB drive, click **OK**, then click **Next**.





Accept the license agreement and click **Next**. Click **Finish** when the installation is complete.





Remove the USB device from our computer and plug it into the controller.


On the controller screen, touch the **Show Menu** button and select the **Control Panels** button.




Select the **Utilities** button, scroll through the list, select **Firmware Upgrade**, then press the **Do Function** button.





Click **OK** at the dialog box, select the appropriate file and click **OK**.



The update takes approximately three minutes. Select **OK** when the firmware has been re-programmed.




Press **Enter** on the keyboard to recalibrate. Recalibrate the Touch Screen by pressing the crosshairs as they appear on the screen. Press **OK** when the touch screen has been calibrated.



Click **OK** when the firmware has been re-programmed.



Return to the Utilities screen, scroll through the list, select **Safely remove USB memory** and click **Do Function**.



Click **OK** on the System Message screen and remove the USB from the controller. Click **Done** on the System Utilities screen.



To validate the firmware version, return to the Home Screen and select the **Status** button. The firmware version will be displayed in the upper right corner of the Status screen.
