

Linx 8940 Spectrum eliminates daily print head cleaning for food manufacturer

INTRODUCTION

An award-winning manufacturer and global exporter of jams, pickles and other food products required pigmented inks to provide good opacity of traceability codes across a range of jar types, including glass and other products.

PROBLEM

Printing on up to 18,000 jars per day/4 days per week, the customer was experiencing high maintenance due to daily print head cleaning and problems with restarts when the machine was left off, even for just one day. They needed a more reliable and hassle-free marking solution.

SOLUTION

The customer noticed a dramatic reduction in daily cleaning and maintenance compared to their previous coder after installing the Linx 8940 Spectrum with opaque blue ink 1043.
